What is the Bunttes Haus and how does it work?

Back in September of 1993, a building at Neumarkt, Celle was squatted, demanding a "Colourful house in a dead city" ("Coulourful House", that's what "Bunttes Haus" literally translates to). From then on, this demand for a self-governed socio-cultural centre was formulated, until, in January 1996, it could be realized. Since then, "Bunttes Haus" exists, developing its emancipatory outlook on the

premises of the "CD-Kaserne", another, more commercial location.

Then and now, we're trying to establish a democratic perspective opposed to capitalism. In practicing grassroots organisation, opposing any forms of oppression such as sexism, fascism, racism nationalism and so on, we're realizing this idea, showing alternatives to the present system.

The grassroots style of organisation is based on a meeting during which all



decisions that are important to us are made.

Also, it's not the point of work and events at Buntes Haus to make profits. On the contrary, they are free of charge and we host partys in order to keep us independent.

These cover all costs, which allows us to support counterculture and offer an educational and political perspective.

MONDAY BAR

Each Monday, the café at Buntes Haus opens for the monday bar. With a long tradition, this bar functions as a meeting place for many people in Celle. And what's new, every third Monday of the month there'll be a motto for the evening.

AK ASYL & MIGRATION CELLE

Every first and third Monday, from 18 to 20 pm, there is an open asylum & igration meeting at Buntes Haus. People of different ages and interests connected to

organize a get-together (taking place every two months) with refugees (called let's meet). Furthermore, a team distributes information material at the refugee camp Scheuen, mostly because proper counsel meetings inside the camp had to be stopped after roughly two months, forbidden by the camp's management.

Last but not least, we're in contact with a few refugees, accompanying them to lawyers, for example, although we do not see this as "guardianship".

"LIST"-MEETING

"Land in sight-Transition"-LIST-Celle is a political initiative, founded in June 2015. Our topics are of a global nature: Climate change, wars, capitalism...Wanting to establish a different world, we're practicing this change locally, wherever protest is necessary, and by getting involved where change, projects and transformatory initiatives emerge. We meet every 1st tuesday each month at 19.30 pm.

ANTIFASCIST LEFT CELLE (ALC)

Using Buntes Haus as well, ALC is dedicated to different political fields, both local and international, such as: neo-nazism, racism, anti-nuclear politics and social struggles.

In doing this, ALC strives for a society which is free, emancipatory and without gender bias.

SILK SCREEN PRINTING LAB

The silk screen printing technique was developed out of screen printing, which has been in use since prehistoric times. Silk screen printing received a boost around the end of World War 2, and since then developed continuously. It is mostly used in industrial, crafts- and art-related contexts.

Today, no other printing technique offers as many fascets as silk screen printing. Simply explained, the principle works by spreading colour on a filter with a special tool. Since the filter does block the colour on some

parts more than others, the motive emerges. This opening and blocking is achieved by various techniques. The silk screen printing lab at Buntes Haus has been around for quite some time, and was used more or less frequently according to interest. Recently, we renewed the workplace with professional equipment. It's open each wednesday from 16 to about 20 pm, offering you the possibility to print your own clothing or get creative with other stuff. A person who can explain how the technique works and help you with questios is always present.

GIVE-AWAY SHOP

With a small party, Celle's first ever give-away shop opened here. Since the bike repair workshop at Buntes Haus went out of use, the give-away shop moved in. The room is accessible from the courtyard. If you'd like a look, just come round during opening hours, on tuesday and thursday, from 17 to 19 pm.

SPORTS

People who want to do different sorts of sports regularly meet at Buntes Haus. From table tennis, basketball or football up to skateboarding or yoga. This, and much more, is possible...

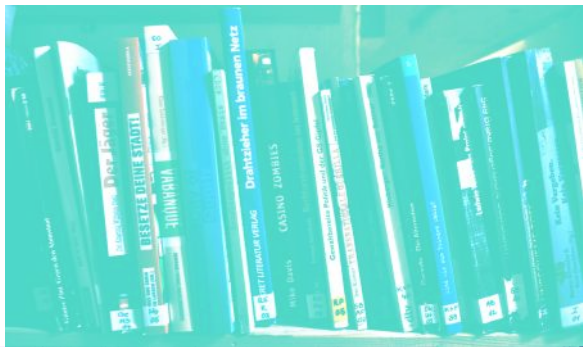
CREATIVITY ROOM

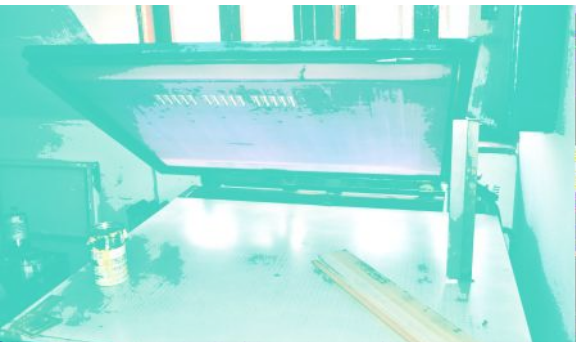

Following the latest regional election's results, we want to address the background of the recent right-wing populism. For this purpose, we've invited Bodo Steffens, consultant for communications and politics at Hanover university's student council, who will give an introduction on the matter. A FIREBRIGADE FOR ROJAVA

For years now, an extremely destructive war is wreaking havoc among civilians in particular, with unnumbered deaths and people fleeing the war zone. In the North, which is mainly populated by kurdisch people, they have decided to take their live into their own hands. In Rojava, a region bordering on Turkey and Iraq, the creation of communal self-government structures has been pushed ahead since 2011. Thus, the people have developed a practical

counteralternative to the old structures marked by violence, exclusion, and demands for power.

The campaign "a fire engine for Rojava" aims to support the people in Rojava and the grass-roots democratic structure they have built. We'll introduce the campaign, its motivation, goals and projects.

PHYSICAL THEATRE

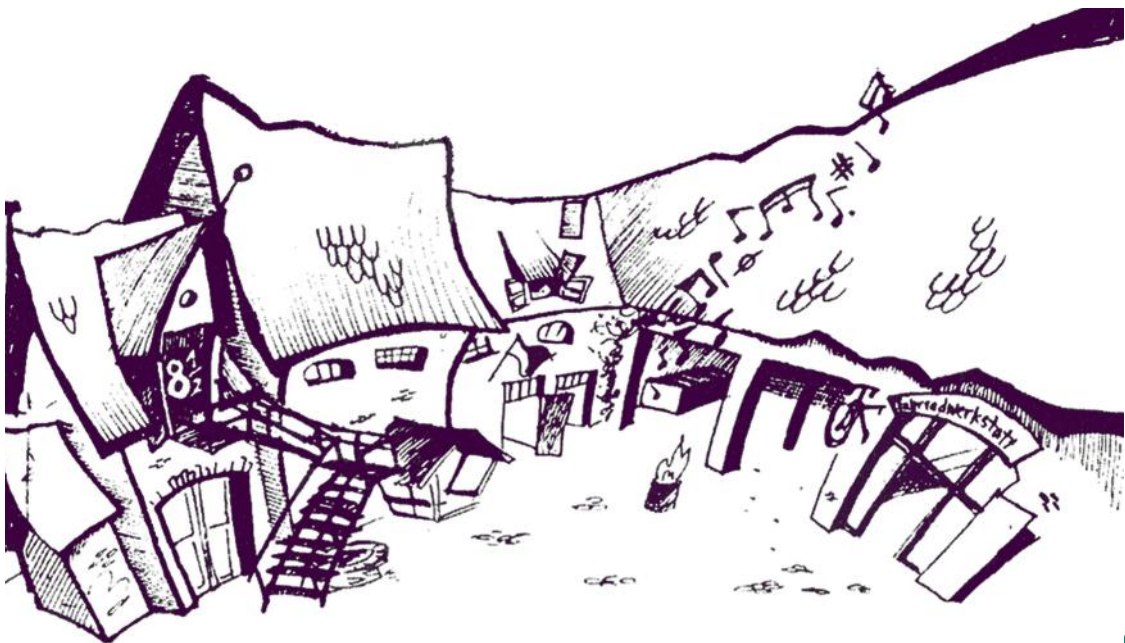
Physical theatre uses the body itself as a form of expression and communication. This workshop will show how to communicate without words and tell a story in this way.
